There is a vacancy on Bradwell Parish Council. Could you get involved?

What does the Parish Council do? The Parish Council includes Heelands, Bradwell Abbey, Bradwell Village, Bradwell Common and Rooksley. The Parish Council runs the Heelands Meeting Place, sports pitches, pays for a dog hygiene service, and helps residents have a voice in planning and development matters by communicating with third parties and planning authorities. The Parish Council manages three allotment sites, all for the benefit of local residents.

Could you get involved as a community leader? you could help by representing people, finding out what the community needs, decision-making and monitoring services in the public interest. It is a voluntary role that may take up 2-3 hours per week. The main commitment is to take part in monthly meetings, usually held on the first Monday evening of the month.
